GUIDELINES

Monmouth Arts' Teen Arts Festival

- > Students may submit a video individually or as a group.
- > Students will be adjudicated <u>per video</u>. During evaluation, students have the opportunity to talk about who did what part—if they so choose.
- No more than 20 student works per school.
- Maximum of 10 minutes in length, as per state festival guidelines.
- ➤ Videos should clearly list student names, school name, title, credits and any other pertinent information.
- ➤ All video students will be adjudicated during one time period with their school.
- ➤ Visual art educators MUST be responsible to upload their students' videos to the assigned Google drive by February 16, 2024. Once evaluation forms are returned to Monmouth Arts, the contact person on the Registration Form will receive an email invitation to upload videos to the designated Google drive.
- ➤ Videos will be viewed by adjudicators in full **PRIOR** to the festival. During the festival, portions will be viewed for all students to watch, but the focus of the evaluation will be on the critique.

Film/Video uploads to Google drive due by February 16, 2024.
