GUIDELINES

Monmouth Arts' Teen Arts Festival

- Students will be adjudicated individually. If your students have a collaborative piece, please contact Vinny Martini to discuss your students' needs.
- All creative writing students will be adjudicated during one time period for each school.
- Individual Students will be adjudicated with other Individual Students.
- No more than 25 entries per school.
- Poetry 2 page maximum.
- Prose 4 page maximum.
- Creative writing and poetry will be read by adjudicators in full PRIOR to the festival.
- All creative writing and poetry submissions are due by February 14, 2020.
- Students may opt to read their own poetry or prose in front of other students during adjudication (though this is not required).
- We also encourage students to read their writing samples during Open Mic, should this occur again in 2020.

***Creative Writing submissions are due by February 14, 2020.**

These must be delivered or mailed to Vinny Martini at the Monmouth Arts office (105 Monmouth St., Red Bank, NJ 07701). Please DO NOT email entries.

Please note that Evaluation Forms with the names of participating students and their titles, genre, and duration are still due by February 2. A copy of the Evaluation Form should be included with the entries when submitted.
